# TEAM ENTRY \$500

Includes an admin fee of \$80.



- The Southeast Challenge is for the **RUNNER-UP** team(s) from your local APA World Qualifier(s). A 3rd Place team may be substituted ONLY if the Runner-Up team is unable to attend.
- If your League is too small to send a team to the APA World Pool Championships, you are able to send one team in each format with permission from the SE Challenge Tournament Director.
- A minimum of 5 players and a maximum of 8 players are allowed on the roster. <u>At least 5 players must be considered original players</u> <u>from their SPRING ROSTER.</u>
- Teams may add up to 3 non-original player who meet the eligibility requirements and are approved by their local league operator.
- Team rosters may not have more than 2 players in common with another roster.

## ELIGIBLE PLAYERS

- A minimum of 5 players and a maximum of 8 players are allowed on the roster. At least 5 players must be considered original from the Spring roster.
- Original participants from the team's Spring 2024 roster who were ineligible to play in their APA World Qualifier due to lack of scores are eligible to participate in this event if they have **20 lifetime scores** within the last 2 years, by **AUGUST 2nd,** in the format the team is registered in.
- Non-original players added to the roster must have at least 20 lifetime matches in any area by AUGUST 2nd, in the format the team is registered in.
- Any player that is on the roster of more than one team is considered a "common player." Players may be on up to two teams in each format.
- All players must be current APA members listed on an active roster in the same format (8-Ball or 9-Ball), with at least one match played in the league area since June 1, 2024. Doubles & Masters teams are not applicable rosters.

## BRACKET AND FIELD

### **Bracket Setup**

Each format (8-Ball & 9-Ball) can accommodate a maximum of 60 teams. To manage time constraints, each event will feature two modified-single elimination (MSE) brackets, resulting in two first-place winners. MSE brackets provide each team with two playing opportunities without facing elimination.

## **Bracket Arrangements**

While we will try to separate teams from the same area initially, we cannot ensure that teams from the same League Area will not compete against each other or against teams with shared players. Additionally, we cannot guarantee that a common player will not be scheduled to participate in both events simultaneously.



# TEAM RESPONSABILITIES

  - There will be no on-site roster changes.

HEAS

The APA Southeast Challenge events (collectively the "Tournament") are operated and administered by American Poolplayers Association, Inc. League Operators (collectively, "APA"). APA, acting through its designated officials, including APA's Handicap Review Committee (the "HRC"), is the Tournament Director for this Tournament. As Tournament Director, APA has the full, absolute, and final authority to make all rulings, decisions, and judgments, in the exercise of its sole discretion, on all issues and matters: related to this Tournament. The Tournament Director's rulings, determinations, and judgments are final.

## TEAM CERTIFICATION STATEMENT

Team Captains must have all players complete and sign the APA SE Challenge Team Certification Statement. This statement will be provided to teams prior to the tournament. Teams must complete and submit the form to register at the event. Only one player needs to be present to turn in the form.

### **IDENTIFICATION REQUIREMENTS**

All tournament participants must have a current and valid photo ID issued by their local government. Players must be able to present their ID at any time and before every match. A proper picture ID is also required for any cash payout. IF YOU DO NOT HAVE A PROPER PICTURE ID, YOU WILL NOT BE ALLOWED TO PLAY!

### SSN REQUIRED

Your Social Security # may be required if you receive a cash payout. The Internal Revenue Service requires that we submit a 1099 Form for anyone who is paid out \$600.00 or more.

### **RESERVE LODGING**

The team will be responsible for obtaining lodging for this event. Several lodging options with discounted rates will be available; please visit the Southeast Challenge Player Facebook Page for more information.

## SKILL LEVELS

Players will play at the highest of their current SL, Spring Session ending SL, or certified SL. Your Local League Operator has reviewed all participants' Skill Levels (SL) prior to this event. If your skill level has been adjusted since your entry form was submitted, your League Operator must notify us prior to the event. Each team is limited to a combined skill level of 23. It is the responsibility of each player to make certain the skill level on their scoresheet is correct.

## BRACKET FORMAT

Each format (8-Ball & 9-Ball) will have a maximum of 48 teams. Each team event will use a modified-single elimination bracket. All teams will have an opportunity to play twice but NOT lose twice in these events.

### **BRACKET SEATING**

Although we will attempt to split up teams from the same area initially, we can NOT guarantee teams from the same League Area will NOT play against each other, or against teams with common players. We also can NOT guarantee a common player will not be scheduled to play in both events during the same round time.
